# ***“Edith Stein, Echt and the Truth”***

*A German philosopher of Jewish descent, Edith Stein converted to Catholicism and became a Carmelite nun. During World War II, she was sent to the Carmelite convent in Echt, Holland. In 1942, the Gestapo stormed the Carmel and demanded that Sister Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) be handed over at once. She was deported and died in Auschwitz.*

Released in 2007 after nine years in the making, this 1 hour documentary film brings Edith Stein's story to life and illuminates the controversy surrounding her canonization.
