



William Doino is a Catholic researcher and commentator who writes a twice-a-month online column for *First Things* magazine, and is a long-time contributing editor to *Inside the Vatican* magazine. He has been writing about religion, politics and culture for over 20 years, been quoted in the *New York Times*, written for the *Times* of London online, and appeared on numerous radio and television programs, including EWTN. Among his special areas of interest is the history of Jewish-Catholic relations about which he has spoken in Rome, London, New York and Washington DC.

Mr. Doino has done extensive work on the Catholic Church's role during the Holocaust, publishing an 80,000 word annotated bibliography in the anthology, *The Pius War*, which was called "masterful" by the *Catholic Historical Review* and a "tour de force" by *National Review*. The Vatican newspaper, the *L'Osservatore Romano* has cited his work, as have many historians and scholarly publications.
