



Dawn Eden Goldstein is the author of *Sunday Will Never Be the Same: A Rock and Roll Journalist Opens Her Ears to God*. Her previous books include *The Thrill of the Chaste* and *My Peace I Give You*.

Goldstein began her writing career as a rock and roll historian, using the pen name Dawn Eden. In the 1990s, she contributed to *Billboard*, the *Village Voice*, *Mojo*, and *Salon* and co-wrote *The Encyclopedia of Singles*. She went on to work in editorial positions at the *New York Post* and the *Daily News*.

At the age of thirty-one, Goldstein, who was raised Jewish, experienced an encounter with the divine, which began a personal transformation that would eventually lead her to enter the Catholic Church. In 2016, she became the first woman to earn a doctorate in sacred theology from the University of St. Mary of the Lake, graduating *summa cum laude*. She has taught at seminaries and universities in the United States, England, and India.

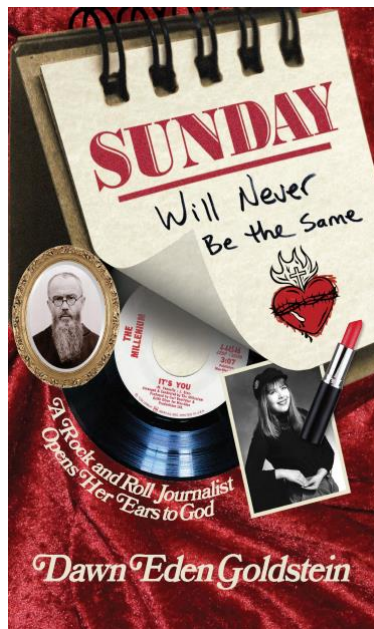
